## Denning Announces Retirement

Larry Denning began his banking career 40 years ago in 1971 when he joined the staff at First Federal Savings and Loan Assn. of Wakeeney. In 1984 he moved his family to Salina when he was hired by First Federal Savings Bank of Wellington to help manage the branch office at 600 S. Santa Fe in Salina. He then joined The Bank of Tescott in December of 1990 when the bank purchased the facility and assets of First Federal. "In essence, I came with the furniture," laughs Denning. Over the years, Larry has experienced some significant changes in the banking field including the advancement of the age of computer adjustable rate mortgage loans, the expansion of types of accounts and services offered to customers, and the increased speed by which banks can approve and provide those accounts and services. Another area of major change has been federal and state regulations effecting how financial institutions can operate in the banking world. "We have moved from the mechanical age to the computer age and that has immensely changed how we do business and provide products and services to our customers," said Larry.

Upon retirement, Larry and his wife, Margo, plan to spend time visiting their two daughters and six grandkids. More community involvement, movies, golf, reading, exercise, and home projects are also among the plans. Denning is presently a member of the Salina AMBUCS Breakfast Club and the Knights of Columbus. "So, if only a few of those work out, we should stay busy and occupied," says Denning. "I will miss the personal contact and interaction with other bank employees and customers of the bank. The variety of duties and challenges will also be missed. I much more prefer a variety than a narrow routine," said Denning.
